These messages have no functional impact on Uptime Infrastructure Monitor operation. To suppress these deprecated entries from the php log, make the following change:

- Edit the //apache/php/php.ini file.
- Change the following line from: error\_reporting = E\_ALL & ~E\_NOTICE & ~E\_WARNING to: error\_reporting = E\_ALL & ~E\_NOTICE & ~E\_WARNING & ~E\_DEPRECATED.
- Save the changes to the php.ini file.
- Restart the Uptime Infrastructure Monitor httpd / web server service to apply the change. After the web server has restarted, tail the php log to verify the change.
