

php error_log file growing due to deprecated messages

Example log messages:

These messages have no functional impact on Uptime Infrastructure Monitor operation. To suppress these deprecated entries from the php log, make the following change:

- Edit the *//apache/php/php.ini* file.
- Change the following line from: *error_reporting = E_ALL & ~E_NOTICE & ~E_WARNING* to: *error_reporting = E_ALL & ~E_NOTICE & ~E_WARNING & ~E_DEPRECATED*.
- Save the changes to the php.ini file.
- Restart the Uptime Infrastructure Monitor http / web server service to apply the change. After the web server has restarted, tail the php log to verify the change.
